We will not have any evening activities or classes tonight and this Wednesday, March 13th. Enjoy Spring Break!

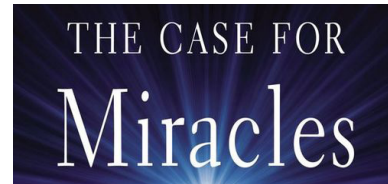
