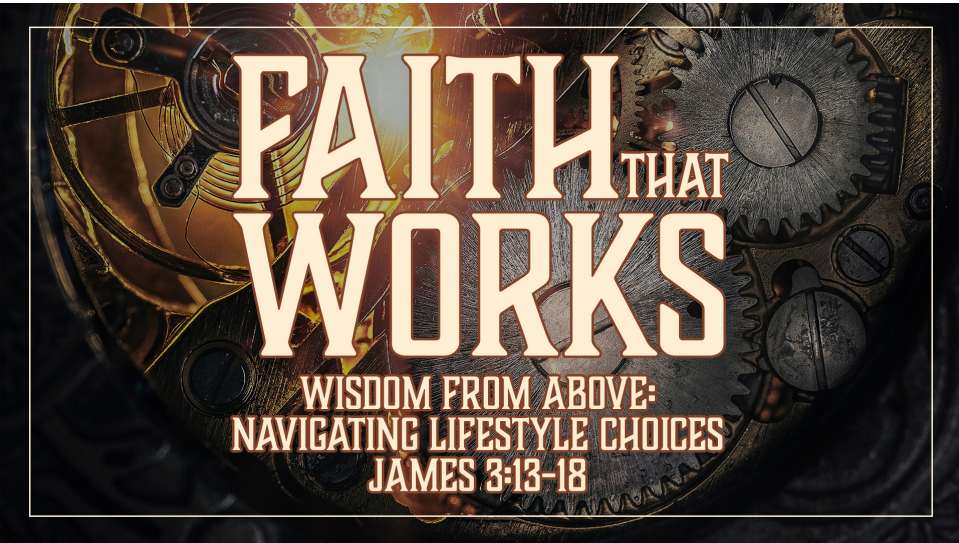

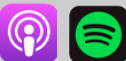

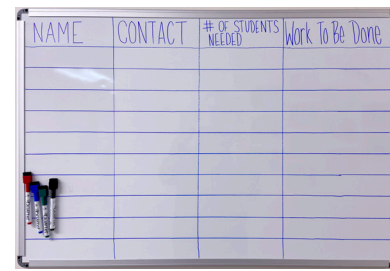
Our next quarterly business meeting is Sunday, December 7th at 4:30 pm. We will vote on the proposed 2026 budget as well
