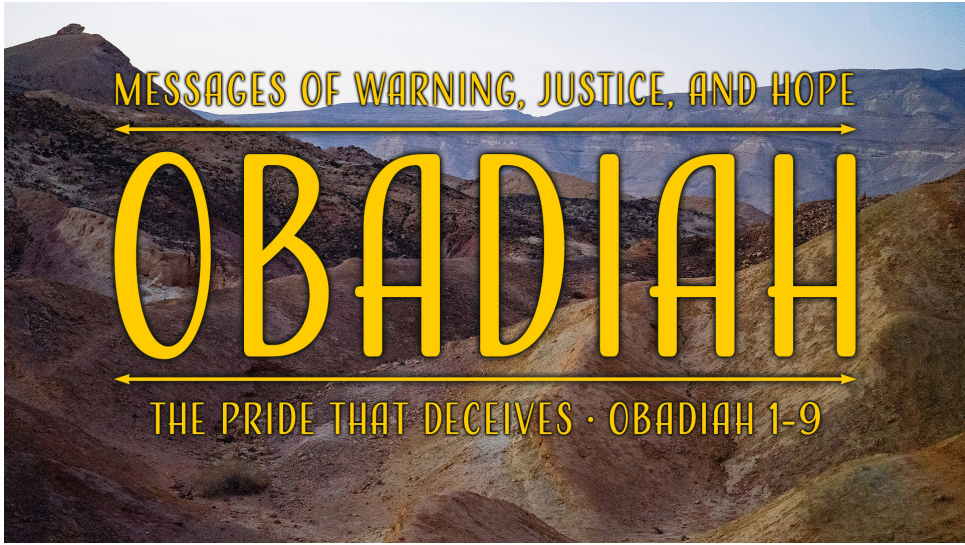

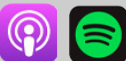

Hunger Fund, which provides meals for children

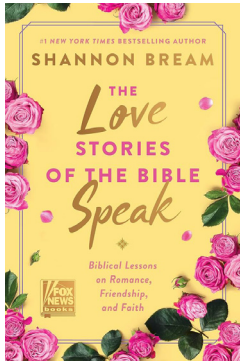
